

Worksite Traffic Management

Why worksite traffic management?

Work Site Traffic Management is the first step in gaining access to working as a traffic controller on road sites during alterations to surfaces, changes to underground infrastructure or any other disruptions to normal traffic progression.

This course imparts the minimum level of information required to allow the participant onto these sites in the capacity of the traffic controller.

This qualification is becoming more in demand as this region receives grants and funding to modify or create new surfaces on the local roads.

This qualification is the minimum level required before the participant can undertake the Traffic Management Supervisor course, and in conjunction with a Construction Induction ticket will allow the participant access to construction sites on all the major Victorian and New South Wales projects.
